## Receptions

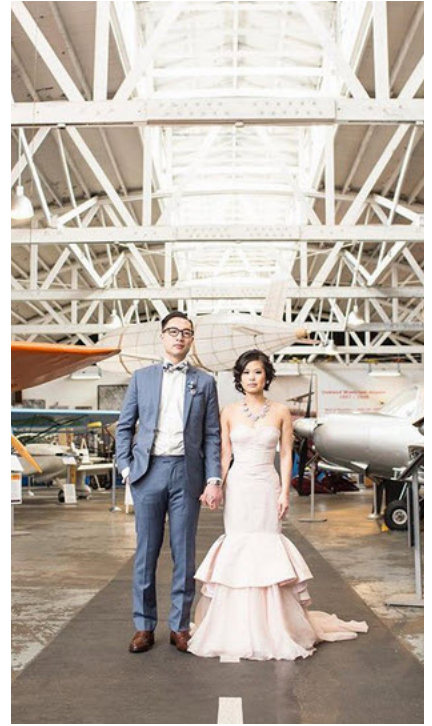
The hanger and outdoor space is ideal for dancing and mingling.

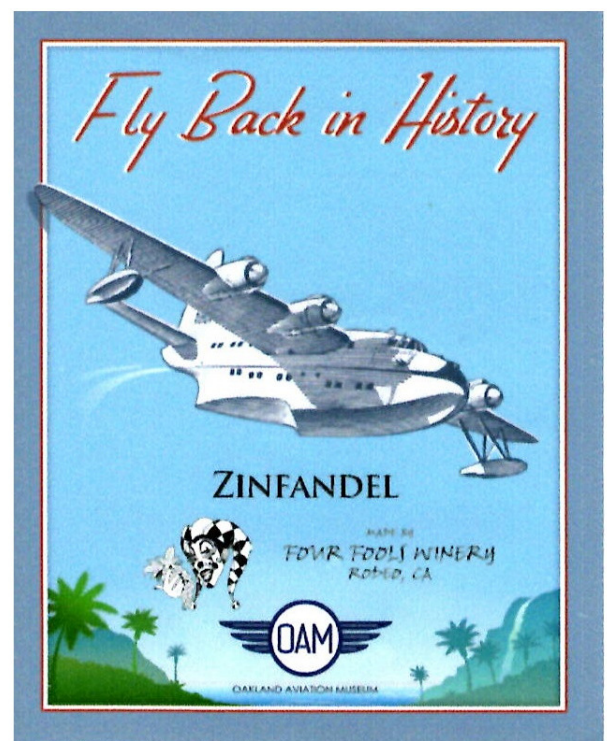

# DIRECTIONS

## Direction from Oakland International Airport

- Take the Rental Car Shuttle Bus to the Rental Car Center.
- Walk to the street exit (Earhart Dr.) and turn left.
- The Museum is two blocks (about 0.3 miles) from the Rental Car Center.

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## Driving Directions

- From 880 North and South.
- Take Hegenberger Road Exit.
- Follow Hegenberger to Doolittle Drive.
- Stay in right lane & cross over Doolittle.
- Go under the Oakland International Airport banner and take the first exit on the right where the Earhart Road and Air Museum signs are visible.
- Follow Earhart Road approx 7/8 of a mile to Museum - right across from Hangar 6.
